Rainbow is always asked what separates our boxed kits from the Costco units so in 2010 we'd like to answer this question upfront:

**First**, be careful what you buy. Costco's PlayStar units either use ACQ lumber, essentially the newer version of pressure-treated lumber, or their models do not include the necessary lumber (be sure to read the details). All three of Rainbow's Backyard Circus models include 100% natural whitewood North-American lumber which is pre-cut, pre-stained, pre-drilled, smoothed and watersealed.

**Next**, Costco's Cedar Summit unit is similar to our Backyard Circus Clubhouse models (the Treehouse or the Funhouse). All three of these units use the same type of lumber: a North American cedar called Cunninghamia Lanceolata. But the difference between these models is in the construction:



Cedar Summit units use two smaller pieces of wood, glues those two pieces together and then paints/laminates the newly formed "post" to look bigger than it really is. Do you know what will happen to this glued post once children begin using/swinging on the playground?

Rainbow units use true 4x4 corner posts in our Backyard Circus models.
